



Summer 2010 in Tampere, Finland Transportation Engineering (open for all disciplines)

Location: Houghton, Chicago, & Tampere, Finland

Dates: May 3 to June 3, 2010 (The program will start in Houghton from Mon., May 3 – Mon., May 10, then the group will travel to Green Bay and Chicago for May 11 - May 13, and then on to Tampere, Finland from Fri, May 14 – Thu., June 3)

Language: English

Housing: Lodging will be provided for Chicago and Tampere. Housing in Houghton for students outside Michigan Tech arranged for a separate fee.

Cost: Program Fee 2010 = \$2,400-2,500 depending on number of students (Includes tuition & fees for 6 credits, lodging in Chicago & Tampere, and field trips)
IPS administrative fee = \$100
Deposit = \$500 non-refundable deposit is due by January 29, 2010 (this will count toward Program Fee)
Meals and personal expenses= \$600-800* (in Chicago & Tampere)
Airfare = \$1,000-1,200* (Chicago-Tampere/Helsinki-Chicago)
